





Have your say on improving hospital services for people in Shropshire, Telford & Wrekin and mid Wales

NHS Shropshire and Telford & Wrekin Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCGs) are proposing to make changes to the hospital services provided at the Princess Royal Hospital and the Royal Shrewsbury Hospital. We have launched a formal public consultation and are asking for your views on two options:

## **Option 1:**

The Royal Shrewsbury Hospital becomes an Emergency Care site and the Princess Royal Hospital becomes a Planned Care site. (This is the CCGs' preferred option)

## Option 2:

The Princess Royal Hospital becomes an Emergency Care site and the Royal Shrewsbury Hospital becomes a Planned Care site.

Under either option, both hospitals would have an Urgent Care Centre that is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
